A Change Is Coming For American Legion Riders



The American Legion Riders (ALR) may change soon. When the ALR was formed in Colorado, it began as a District program with one ALR group per district. ALR District 4 was created August 31, 2007. Since then, nearly all other states have converted to a Chapter status, meaning that an individual Post now has the opportunity to host its own ALR chapter.

If or when this goes into effect for Colorado, any Post with at least seven riding members (Legion, Auxiliary and/or SAL) may apply for its own Charter through their Post commander. This new concept gives a Post the opportunity to grow its membership and gives the Legion, Auxiliary and SAL the ability to work together, since membership can include all.


To form a Chapter, a Post commander may apply for a Charter when a minimum of seven riders are interested. Each Post commander will be in control of its ALR Charter.

At the least, a Chapter will be comprised of a Director, Assistant Director, Secretary, Treasurer, Road Guide and Sgt-at-Arms, plus one general member. If a Post cannot muster enough riders for its own Chapter, anyone still wishing to belong to a Chapter may apply to another Post for ALR membership there. This would not affect a rider's basic membership in his/her own Post.

Officers of the American Legion and ALR are currently drafting a new constitution and by-laws for Post-level Chapters which should be ready for presentation at the Mid-Year Convention; afterwhich, formal adoption would most likely occur at the June State Convention. The new by-laws will approximate the existing ones, with one significant change: no profane language or symbols will be allowed anywhere on a rider's vest.






